## Overview:

Also, assist the Horsemanship Director and Horsemanship Camp Coordinator in running the weekend horsemanship programs.

## Key Areas of Responsibility and Essential Functions:

- - Care for the physical needs of campers (ensure safety, cleanliness, and healthy practices)
- - Teach basic riding and horsemanship skills to campers
- - Ensure the safety of everyone at the barn
- - Facilitate the camper experience, which includes: campfires, games, trail rides, etc. as directed by the Horsemanship Camp Coordinator
- - Feed and care for the Timberlake animals as directed by the Horsemanship Director
- - Invest time in each camper's spiritual growth by leading daily group devotions and Bible studies, riding lessons and conversations
- - At all times know the location of each camper assigned to you
- - Become familiar with and obey all camp policies and procedures
- - Make camp a safe, fun and welcoming place for campers while ensuring that they are aware of and following camp policies
- - Report symptoms of ill health promptly to the Camp First Aider
