

NCTA Tobacco Policy

No tobacco products may be used in facilities or vehicles of the University of Nebraska-Nebraska College of Technical Agriculture (NCTA). This includes electronic cigarettes or other forms of electronic smoking.

Use of tobacco products on the grounds of any NCTA site is allowed as long as such use is not within close proximity (defined as within 10 feet) of any building perimeter.

As in the past, NCTA will attempt to aid persons who wish to stop smoking by providing remedial mechanisms authorized by the University's benefits program. Faculty and staff may contact the Employee Assistance Program (EAP) at 402-472-3107 or eap@unl.edu and students may contact Health Education and Outreach at 402-472-5000.

Facilities Management coordinates signage reflecting this policy, and tobacco waste receptacle placement.

Noncompliance with these provisions will be managed in accordance with existing human resource guidelines with regard to faculty and staff, and existing Student Affairs guidelines as far as students are concerned.
