Coach Alan Taylor and team members coordinate the match from 1-4 p.m.

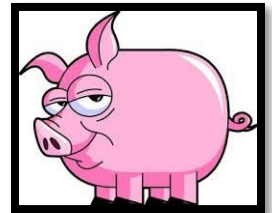
“A huge thank you to all who support the Aggies, and particularly to the City of Curtis for use of the facilities,” Taylor said.
