Student Eligibility and Requirements

- Eligible candidates must be a traditional (age 18-22) full-time student enrolled in agricultural coursework.
- Candidates must possess a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.500.
- Applicants must have permanent residence in Nebraska, Iowa, South Dakota, Kansas, Wyoming, North Dakota, Minnesota or Wisconsin.
- Preference is given to those who intend to return to the farm/ranch or a farm related job in a rural community.
- Financial need will not be considered.
- If selected as the recipient, an acceptance letter indicating the student's future would be appreciated.
- The scholarship amount is to be paid as follows: \$1000 in fall 2026 semester and \$1000 paid in spring 2027 semester to each recipient.
